

Script for helpers to explain the ExpressVote to voters

The ExpressVote does not count votes; it only marks your ballot. I'm going to enter your ward number so that it calls up the correct ballot for your neighborhood.

Note to election official, who enters the ward number: Use 3 digits when entering the ward. This reduces the number of results. Example: for ward 12, enter 012.

School district – several wards have more than one school district. Check the envelope label for the correct one.

As you can see, it is a touchscreen. You make your selections, page by page, office by office. You can make changes during the process.

The last contest is a referendum, and then there is a review screen. There are three pages of review screens. Check that all your selections are shown correctly. If you want to make a change, touch the office to make a change.

When you are satisfied with the review screen, touch PRINT. It prints your selections on the ballot, and ejects it. Please check that the selections printed on the ballot are correct.

Then, fold the ballot in half, put it into the envelope, and bring it to us to witness your signature.

If additional questions arise...

If you skip a contest by pressing NEXT, an alert appears. Read the alert, then touch NEXT if your intention is to skip this contest.
